RE: Bridal Falls Gondola Project

This letter will serve to confirm our support and interest in-principle for the proposed Bridal Falls Gondola Project (the "Project") as presented to us recently on March 7, 2017 at our Council meeting held at our Administration offices. It is our belief that this Project fits well with the goals and aspirations of our community and the Project is consistent with the values that are fundamental to our health, sustainability and success as a community. The Chief and Council conditionally supports the Project on the following basis:

1. The Chief and Council supports the Project in principal;
2. The Chief and Council has a duty to ensure the Aboriginal Title and Rights of the Band are protected and accommodated, adverse impacts mitigated and compensation be provided for any adverse affects;
3. The Consultation for the Project be timely and meaningfully addresses any concerns of the Chief and Council to be explored through meaningful dialogue of all parties;
4. That all environmental and traditional use issues be resolved to the Chief and Councils satisfaction;
5. The Bridal Falls Gondola Corporation will provide capacity funding to the Band to meaningfully assess the potential adverse affects of the Project and to consider options for economic participation in the Project; and
6. That economic participation of the Band in the Project will be set out in a Joint Benefits Agreement.

We recognize that there is still much work to be completed and approved with the master plan, environmental assessment process, permitting and other approval and consultation still needed to be completed with other stakeholders, regulatory authorities and institutions. It is with the foregoing expectations and commitments of the Bridal Falls Gondola Corporation to the Band, that the Chief and Council have chosen to support the Project.

Together we will look to pursue a vision and collaborative partnership based upon mutual respect and aligned interests. It is also our wish to establish a Memorandum of Understanding with the Corporation as soon as possible and a subsequent Joint Benefits Agreement between the Corporation and the Band to solidify the working and business relationship between the Corporation and the Band.

We look forward to working with you in respect to the Project.
